Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

Irvine Ranch Water District (IRWD) owns, operates and maintains a 21-inch sewer line on Main Street which was transferred from the Orange County Sanitation District. IRWD typically installs a sewer manhole on every 400 feet of sewer pipe. On the 21-inch sewer pipe in Main Street north of MacArthur Boulevard, there are 1,200 feet between the nearest manholes preventing the IRWD crews from fully cleaning this reach of the pipe. This project includes construction of a manhole for cleaning and maintenance purposes and does not expand capacity of the existing sewer system. The project location is shown in Figure 1.


