Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

The Irvine Ranch Water District (IRWD) owns and operates the Portola Zone 9 Reservoir which is located in the foothills approximately 1000 feet south of Santiago Canyon Rd. Unsurfaced access roads (Whiting Spur Road and Whiting Road) serving the Portola Zone 9 Reservoir have been closed due to safety concerns related to slope failure and landslides. IRWD proposes to conduct geotechnical exploration (soil bore testing) to assess the extent of the damage and aid in road repair design. The work will include boring activities at the areas noted as slope failure area of Whiting Spur Road and the landslide area of Whiting Road on the attached Figure 1-Project Vicinity. The work will be contained to the footprint of the access roads and shall take approximately one week to complete. This Notice of Exemption (NOE) only applies to geotechnical exploration

activities, and additional California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) compliance will be conducted prior to implementation of the actual repairs.
