Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

The East Orange County Water District (EOCWD) Interconnection Rehabilitation Project will rebuild the interconnection between Irvine Ranch Water District (IRWD) and EOCWD on Jamboree Road in the City of Orange. The interconnection between IRWD and EOCWD, located on Jamboree Road near Canyon View, was originally built in 1988. The interconnection included a pressure relief valve (PRV) station and a flow meter to provide water from EOCWD to IRWD. Since 1992, the interconnection has been only used in emergency situations. A few years ago the programmable logic controller (PLC) cabinet, which controls the opening and closing of the valves, was damaged when it was hit by a vehicle, severing the interconnection's use. This project will rehabilitate the interconnection through the installation of new control cabinets.


