Project Location: The Residential Recycled Water Fill Station is adjacent to IRWD headquarters at 15600 Sand Canyon Avenue in Irvine, CA (See Exhibit "A")

Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

Irvine Ranch Water District (IRWD) plans to initiate a program which would make recycled water available to all of its residential customers through a public water fill station. IRWD will provide recycled water free of charge to residents to water trees, gardens and lawns at their homes or to wash outdoor furniture and hard surfaces. This program is intended to help the IRWD community with reducing its use of potable water during the current drought.

In order to implement this program, IRWD will modify the existing two-inch recycled water service, currently serving the landscaping at IRWD's Sand Canyon offices, and install six recycled water fill stations. Four back-in style fill stations and two drive-through style fill stations will be added. Additional fill stations can be added at the site as necessary.

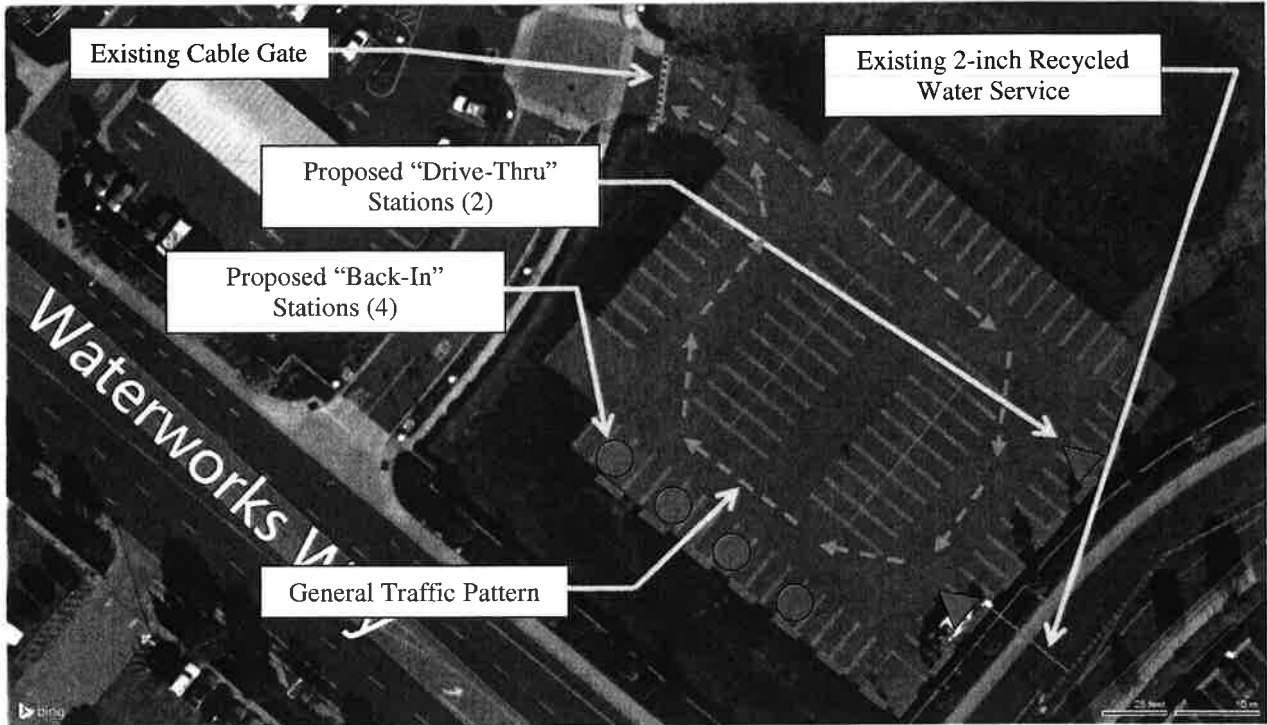
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Exhibit "A"
