Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

The Irvine Business Complex (IBC), located in the western part of the City of Irvine, consists of a range of industrial, office, commercial, and residential uses covering approximately 2,800 acres. The City of Irvine is proposing to add sidewalks to three areas within IBC including Millikan Avenue from DuBridge Avenue to Barranca Parkway including DuBridge, Noyes, Gates and Hale Avenues; Armstrong Avenue, between Alton Parkway and Barranca Parkway; and Teller Avenue, north of Campus Drive.

This project will relocate approximately 60 Irvine Ranch Water District (IRWD) facilities, e.g. meters, hydrants, and backflow devices. These existing facilities are currently located behind the curb and require relocation to avoid conflict with the City's proposed sidewalk installation. These facilities will be relocated immediately adjacent to their existing location so as to avoid the new sidewalks.


