Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

Irvine Ranch Water District (IRWD) owns and operates 16-inch and 20-inch domestic water and 24-inch and 36-inch recycled water pipelines in the City of Irvine. The cement mortar lined and steel coated pipes have experienced two external corrosion failures.

This project will install cathodic protection on the pipeline segments. Cathodic protection is a pipe corrosion prevention method in which a very small electrical current is sent throughout the pipe. The affected segments include an approximately 3,700 linear feet segment, located on Quail Hill Parkway between East Knoll Crest and Shady Canyon Road, an approximately 5,300 linear feet segment, located on Quail Hill Parkway between Laguna Canyon Road and Shady Canyon Road, and an approximately 8,200 linear feet segment, located on Laguna Canyon Road between Barranca Parkway and Romano.
