Irvine Ranch Water District (IRWD) has entered into a purchase agreement for approximately 554 acres of land (Property) near the City of Blythe, in unincorporated Riverside County California. The Property is referenced as APN 878-151-003; APN 878-210-001; APN 878-270-001, 002 and APN 878-260-001, 002. IRWD is not presently contemplating changes in the existing use of the land. The existing use of a portion of the land includes, without limitation, fallowing in exchange for water supply consideration pursuant to an applicable ongoing program. IRWD will obtain water supply benefits in the service area of IRWD. Environmental impacts associated with the Property acquisition are not expected.
