Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

Irvine Ranch Water District (IRWD) owns and operates Rattlesnake Reservoir, located on IRWD property in the foothills of Irvine, north of Portola Parkway, between Jeffrey Road and Orchard Hills. Rattlesnake Reservoir is an uncovered reservoir which contains recycled water produced by IRWD at its Michelson Water Recycling Plant. The reservoir has provided seasonal storage of recycled water for over 40 years. This water is used for irrigation of parks, golf courses and greenbelts, and for industrial and commercial purposes throughout IRWD's service area.

Based on the issues observed during IRWD's routine maintenance inspections of the reservoir's outlet flow metering system, this project will install a new 30-inch butterfly valve, a new magnetic flow meter, three valve actuators, and all of the valve operating stem couplings and supports, which are located on the reservoir's inside-bank. In order to remove the actuators, the work will be conducted during the fall/winter when the level of the stored water is at its lowest. Relocation of some of the accumulated silt around the deepest actuator, located at the bottom of the reservoir, will be needed so that crews can

replace the actuator. The accumulated silt will remain in the reservoir but will be moved to other areas within the reservoir that are free of construction work.


