Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

Irvine Ranch Water District (IRWD) owns and operates the existing Dyer Road Well Field (DRWF) located in the City of Santa Ana off of Harvard Avenue, as seen in Figure 1. Well 12, located within the DRWF, was constructed in 1981 and has experienced decreased production over time.

Recent inspections and review of the flow data for the well have determined that the well will require rehabilitation in order to restore its capacity. Work to be performed on the well involves mechanical cleaning, including wire brushing, scrubbing the well walls, repair of any wall defects, swabbing and airlifting. The well will be redeveloped, chemically treated, and tested. Work will include necessary repairs of the pump and motor assemblies. There will be no expansion of use of the respective well sites as a result of this project.
