Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

The Irvine Ranch Water District (IRWD) and Serrano Water District (SWD) jointly operate the Santiago Creek Dam which impounds Irvine Lake. The Division of Safety of Dams has requested a seismic stability review for the Santiago Creek Dam that would evaluate the potential for streambed alluvium under the dam to liquefy during a design earthquake and the status of a fault that passes under the dam, referred to as the Terrace Fault. The investigation of the alluvium will require sonic drilling in four locations, and the Terrace Fault investigation will require 160 feet of exploratory trench. Both investigations will be conducted at the toe of the dam. The project will last approximately 3 weeks.
